# EUROPEAN CHAMPIONSHIP 5-Pin's JUNIORS

# **RULES**

### Art. 1. GENERAL RULES

a) The European Championship 5-Pins Juniors Single will be organized with 16 participants.

In order to minimize the organizing cost and allow to all the European Federations to organize the event it will be organized at the same time and location of the EC 5-Pins Seniors.

- b) The aim is to have one event every two years.
- c) The tournament will start on Thursday evening with the draw lots and will last till Sunday evening.
- d) The tournament will be played on a minimum number of four billiard tables.
- e) The organizing Federation is responsible for the organizational costs (tournament place, billiard tables, referees, etc.).

### Article 2 - RIGHT OF PARTICIPATION

Are qualified to take part in the European Championships Juniors the sportsmen not older than 20 years and 364 days counted on 1st September of the sporting year concerned.

### Art. 3. PARTICIPANTS

The European Championship 5-Pins Juniors Single will be organized with 16 participants. These are:

- a) The titleholder, with no consideration for his nationality, in so far as the winning of the title is not longer than 4 years ago and not older than 20 years and 364 days counted on 1st September of the sporting year concerned.
- b) One or two representatives from each of the affiliated Federations, which are allowed to participate.
- c) One sportsman who will be determined by the organizing federation.

If a federation cannot replace a weakness of a participant, this place will be occupied by a sportsmen of the organizing federation.



## Art. 4. PLAYING SYSTEM - DISTANCES - BREAK

#### QUALIFYING ROUND

- a) The qualifying round is played in 4 groups of 4 sportsmen, in each group everyone is playing against everyone.
- b) Concerning the making of the groups they will be made by drawing lots, splitting sportsmen of the same nationality in different groups.

In the groups it is playing as follows:

- 1 4 and 2 3
- Winner winner and loser loser
- The remaining games

In case there are two or more sportsmen of the same nationality in the same group those will have to play first against each other.

The groups A and B as well as the groups C and D will play at the same time.c) If a sportsman is not present at a game his opponent will receive 1 match point and 2-0 set points. The sportsman has to be ready to play ten minutes before the beginning of his match otherwise he is losing the right to test the material.

- d) The organizer will give the persons involved a timetable at the beginning of the event. The sportsmen have to be at disposal ready to play in the tournament hall at the times given therein. Otherwise their right to participate is expiring.
- e) Between two matches coming after each other the sportsman shall have at least a break of 15 minutes. (Article 7004, paragraph 2 and article 7005 paragraph 1/2 of the EOR)
- f) After the games in the groups the two first of each group will play further in the final round according to the KO-system.

#### **GAMES**

- a) The set system is applied.
- b) In the groups one will play two winning sets (best of 3)
- c) The distance of one set is amounting to 50 points.
- d) Before the beginning of the match one will determine by means of the cushion decision which sportsmen is starting. The winner of the cushion decision determines who is starting with the first set. That one is also starting the sets 3 and eventually set 5, the opponent has in set 2 and eventually set 4 the first stroke. The sportsman who is starting the 1st set is always starting with the pure white ball and is keeping this one during the whole match.
- e) The sportsmen do have the right to make a break of about 5 minutes after the 2<sup>nd</sup> and the 4<sup>th</sup> set.
- f) Within the framework of public interest (television) the organizer is allowed to extend the break or to also make a break between other sets.



## Art. 5. RANKINGS AFTER THE GAMES OF THE GROUPS

The places 1 - 4 are received by the winners of the groups. The places 5 - 8 by the sportsmen who are second in the groups

The places 9 - 12 by the sportsmen who are third in the groups

The places 13 - 16 by the sportsmen who are fourth in the groups

## PROCEDURE IN ORDER TO CLASSIFY SPORTMEN

a) Total number of match points achieved

b) In case of "drawn" among two sportsmen, the direct encounter will decide.

- With more than two sportmen the last will be determinated with the following criteria: 1) Set points (highest positively difference between winning and loosing
  - sets)
  - 2) Average of the sportsmen involved (3 positions after the point, rounding down)

For the remaining two the direct encounter will be valued.

## Art. 6. FINAL ROUND - KO-ENCOUNTERS

a) The first 8 sportsmen qualified from the eliminatory round will play the following encounters:

b) The set system is applied.One will play three winning sets (best of 5).



### Art. 7. SPORT SUPPORTING PRIZES

Sport supporting prizes will not be compensated. The four classified first will receive the medals of the CEB. A diploma will be given to each participant.

### Art. 8. TRAVEL EXPENSES AND ALLOWANCES

Travelling expenses are supported entirely by the federations delegating of the players. Each federation will be compensated by the CEB at a rate of a fixed price of  $\in$  300.00 for its participation. This allowance is carried out to  $\in$  450.00 if the federation in question takes part with 2 sportsmen or more. The sportsmen will have to be accompanied by an official delegate of their federation.

### Art. 9. DAILY REIMBURSEMENTS

Daily allowances will not be versed.

### Art. 10. INVITATIONS

The invitations will be published on the website of the CEB at least 10 weeks before the beginning of the championship.

### Art. 11. INSCRIPTIONS

The closing date for inscriptions is laid down to about 6 weeks before the opening of the championship. The exact date of the closing date for inscriptions will be made known on the occasion of the beginning of the inscriptions.

### Art. 12. ADVERTISEMENT ON THE CLOTHES

See annex 7 of the EOR. The organizer has the right to impose on the sportsmen to wear an appropriate advertisement and/or to forbid them in certain cases to wear own individual advertisements.

This has to be published in the invitation.

### Art. 13. OTHER REGULATIONS

Regulations which are not specifically defined in these rules will come into force following the other rules and statutes of the CEB. In case of doubt the committee or the delegate of the CEB is deciding.



## Art. 14. COMING INTO FORCE

These rules will come into force at the beginning of the sporting season 2007/2008. It annuls all previous and contrary regulations.

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
